


Holiday Camp Programme 2019

The holiday camp programme for 2019 from Childminding is designed for children aged between 3,5 and 12 years, (Pre-Primary to Secondary 2) The weeks of the holiday camps are differentiated in age-specific groups(see chart below).

PP = Pre-Primary
P1 = Primary 1
P2 = Primary 2
P3 = Primary 3
P+S = Primary 4 - Secondary 2

From the first day of the summer holidays the differentiation will be according to the classes of the school year 2019/2020.

From 5th August until 9th August, on September 2nd and during the winter holidays Childminding will be closed due to company holidays.

New: Professional external vendors will be enhancing our holiday camps in 2019.

Our opening hours during the camps are from 08:00 am until 06:15 pm Monday to Friday.

We will inform all parents and children prior to the start of each holiday camp week with letter about the exact programme and the weekly topic orientated excursion.


Pre-Primary:

Pre-Primary:



Participation Conditions for the holiday camp programme 2019

Our Holiday Camps are open to all children aged between 3,5 and 12 years (Pre-Primary to Secondary 2). Members of the Parents Association of the European School Frankfurt, who submit registrations within the deadline, will receive a 50 € discount.

Holiday Camps and their contents are not guaranteed and may be subject to change. In the unlikely event of changes, parents will be informed as soon as possible.

Registrations for Holiday Camps are made online via the website of the Parents Association at www.eurokids.gmbh. Registrations are binding!

50% cancellation fee is charged for cancellations made up to 14' days prior the start of the camp. For cancellations

made less than 14 days of the start, we charge 100% of the costs.

The number of participants per week is limited. Registrations are processed according to the date of receipt. If the capacity is exceeded, parents will be informed. The deadline for registration is to be observed. Registrations, which are made after the deadline, will not be eligible for a Parents Association member discount.

By signing the holiday camp registration parents agree that their child is allowed to participate in our excursions. Please inform us about allergies and important information related to your children when completing the holiday camp registration.
